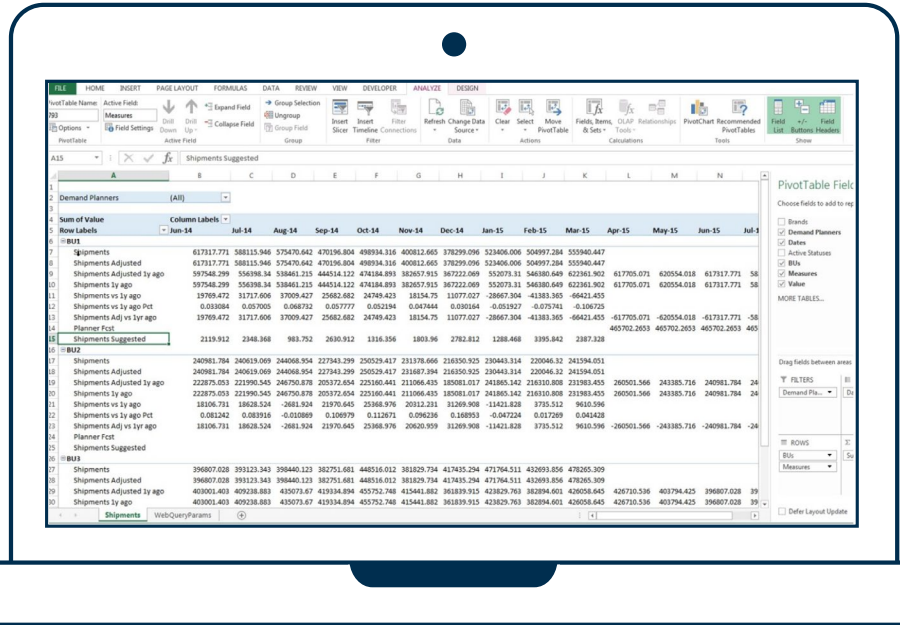


Using pivot tables in Microsoft Excel with your Adexa application
